- High School graduating senior or transfer from MCC (new student at Bellevue University)
- US Citizen, Legal Permanent Resident, Deferred Action student
- Full-time enrollment and pursuing a bachelor's degree
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5
- Financial need documentation required (FAFSA or Federal Student Aid Estimator if FAFSA ineligible)
- Active TeamMates mentee for at least 3 years
- Residents of Nebraska or Iowa

faq's about the TeamMates Dream Scholarship

Q: Is this scholarship awarded per term throughout the duration of enrollment?

A: This scholarship is awarded per academic year, and is split between enrolled terms. If all eligibility requirements continue to be met during the first year of enrollment, this scholarship may be renewed for additional academic years.

Q: Can this scholarship be applied to room and board?

A: Yes, this scholarship can pay towards tuition, fees, books, as well as on-campus housing and food.

Q: Can this scholarship be refunded?

A: Yes, this scholarship is refundable.

Q: Are there programmatic requirements that must be met in order to receive the scholarship?

A: Yes, there are certain requirements that must be met throughout the course of the academic year. You must be enrolled full-time, maintain a 2.5 cumulative GPA, and take LA 105 and pass with a grade of C+ or better. You must also participate in all of the required scholarship activities and orientation.

Q: Are there requirements from TeamMates that must be met in order to receive the scholarship?

A: Yes, there are certain requirements that must be met throughout the course of the academic year. You must adhere to all post-secondary mentorship requirements, meet with your TeamMates mentor on campus at least six times per year, and communicate with your mentor at least once a month by phone, email or text.

Q: Can this scholarship be stacked with other types of aid?

A: Yes, this scholarship may be combined with other types of aid depending on your total financial aid package. If there are concerns about stacking, please contact the scholarships and grants department at 402-293-2000 | scholarships@bellevue.edu.

Q: Can this scholarship be applied to previous terms/charges on my account prior to receiving the scholarship?

A: No, it cannot.

Q: Is this scholarship renewable?

A: Yes, this scholarship may be received for up to 5 years or until you earn a bachelor's degree (whichever comes first), as long as you fulfill the scholarship eligibility and maintenance requirements.

Q: How do I renew this scholarship for each new academic year?

A: Renewal criteria are reviewed at the beginning of your first academic year during a required scholarship orientation session.
